John Hanson Community School will inspire pupil premium students to 'Aim High' and achieve success by promoting emotional resilience and academic progress.

1 Teaching

Quality Teaching and Learning - the JHCS Principles of Instruction secure the foundations of learning to ensure sustained progress.

Reading, Writing and Oracy - the focus on: subject-specific vocabulary; guided reading across the curriculum and opportunities to verbalise ideas through 'Add, Build and Challenge'.

John Hanson Standard - developing students' effective learning behaviours (e.g. independence and curiosity).

Learning to Learn - effective independent revision tools (flash cards/ Cornell notes/ mind maps).

Aim High Programme - daily home learning support for Years 7-10 to promote personal development and academic

Aim High – a whole school approach to ensuring that pupil premium students' needs are always considered and that support is personalised to the individual.



2 Targeted academic support

Faculty Interventions - additional support delivered through Period 6 and Core subject KS3 & KS4 tutoring.

Literacy and Numeracy - in-class/small group intervention sessions delivered by Maths & English specialist Teaching Assistants.

Reading Proficiency - robust assessment of all students' reading ability and bespoke packages implemented by our reading proficiency specialist.

3 Wider strategies

Equipment –. Study guides and calculators are also provided.

Support with laptops and IT to access home learning offered
Attendance - early intervention and bespoke support for students that tackles barriers to improve attendance.

Careers - provision of tailored and additional career guidance & support at year 9 options and for post 16 options.

Social and Mental Well-Being - personalised and prioritised support to improve student wellbeing (Flex etc)

Trips/Clubs - broadening students' cultural experiences through financial support.
